HISTORIC CHICAGO BUNGALOW INITIATIVE

Notice to Applicants

If you are applying for a building permit for a 2nd floor addition, dormer addition, rear addition or any other type of additional enclosed space or exterior alteration for your bungalow and if you are planning on using any of the Historic Chicago Bungalow Initiative Grant Incentives such as:

1. The Energy Savers Grant
2. The Energy Efficient Appliance Voucher
3. Bungalow Restricted Income Grants

Your plans must be reviewed and approved by Staff from the Historic Chicago Bungalow Association prior to the issuance of a Building Permit.

The Historic Chicago Bungalow Association (HCBA) will review plans for compliance with their design guidelines. If the proposed project meets their design guidelines the HCBA will issue a signed approval letter to the Department of Construction and Permits.

All Certified Historic Chicago Bungalow homeowners receive the Design Guidelines in member packets. They can also be found on the HCBA website chicagobungalow.org
