**Call for Nominations for 5th Annual
Richard H. Driehaus Foundation Bungalow Awards**
Winners Honored with \$750 Cash Prize

CHICAGO (July 13, 2009) – Chicago’s love of bungalows, and owners’ efforts to renovate and restore them, will earn much-deserved recognition this year through the 5th Annual Richard H. Driehaus Foundation Bungalow Awards. Created by the Historic Chicago Bungalow Association, with the support of the Richard H. Driehaus Foundation, these awards honor the creativity and efforts of owners of Chicago’s unique Historic Bungalows for the work they’ve done in interior and exterior renovations, landscaping and restoration.

Nominations can be received from an owner for their own homes, or Bungalows can be nominated by a neighbors, friend or neighborhood association. Nominated projects can be whole homes or single rooms and will be judged by a panel composed of architects, journalists and civic leaders. All nominations are due by August 28 and on-site viewing of the nominated Bungalows will be conducted on September 12 and 13.

Awards will be given in five categories:

- **Interior Restoration** that preserves the detail and form of the historic structure
- **Interior Rehabilitation** that demonstrates a contemporary use of space while maintaining the integrity and distinctive features of the structure
- **Exterior Rehabilitation** that is consistent with the lines and look of the particular bungalow and those around it
- **Landscape Design** that demonstrates creative design solution.
- **Green Project** that demonstrates the use of energy-efficient design and renovation while maintaining classic features

First place winners and honorable mentions in each category will be honored at the 2009 Historic Chicago Bungalow and Green Home Expo on October 17th at the Merchandise Mart, where a photo exhibit of past and present winners will be displayed.
